I am <u>your constituent</u> and a member of AAUW-PA an association that provides ongoing support for legislation to improve the lives of WOMEN, FAMILIES, & ALL citizens in our County. I write to express my disappointment with the failure of the House to take action on:

- <u>SB12</u> a minimum wage increase from \$7.15 (since 2007) to \$12.00 in 2019/\$12.50 in 2020. Was introduced March 22, referred to the Labor and Industry Committee. NO ACTION for the rest of 2019.
- <u>SB580</u> Family Care Act to establish a state insurance program for medical and family leave. Was introduced July 8, referred to the Labor and Industry Committee. NO ACTION for the rest of 2019.
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- <u>SB614</u> to prevent discrimination for gender orientation. Was introduced May 1 referred to House State Government Committee. NO ACTION in 2019.

It is apparent that the process for moving bills forward can be blocked by small committees who choose to prevent any interaction by the whole House, often based on politics & party. I therefore, rely on you as my representative to move forward these bills that can, if acted upon, profoundly improve the lives of our citizens. I challenge you to answer my concerns in 2020.
