From AY 2014-2020, the Indiana (PA) Branch of the American Association of University Women has offered \$500 scholarships in two categories - 1) non-traditional women students; 2) women students earning a minor in women's studies - in partnership with the Women's and Gender Studies program at Indiana University of Pennsylvania and (since 2019) the Women's Studies program at Saint Francis University. Both universities are AAUW Collegiate Institutional members. All applicants must be AAUW Collegiate Members. Eligibility criteria for these years are listed in #1 & 2 below. In AY 2021, the scholarship criteria changed to include women students in any majors with the eligibility for this year listed below in #3. - 1. IUP or SFU Non-traditional Student A \$500 scholarship award for an IUP or SFU Undergraduate or Graduate Woman Student with a residential address in Indiana County (PA) or on-campus who has earned at least 30 undergraduate or 6 graduate credits, and considers herself to be a non-traditional student (defined as women who have delayed enrollment or have challenges in their academic progress because of family, dependents, economic or other extenuating circumstances).
- 2. IUP or SFU Women's Studies Student A \$500 scholarship award for an IUP or SFU Undergraduate Woman Student with a residential address in Indiana County (PA) or on-campus who has earned at least 30 undergraduate credits, and is pursuing a Women's Studies Major or Minor.
- 3. Criteria 2021 to present. A \$500 scholarship award for a current IUP or SFU undergraduate or graduate student who identifies as a woman, has earned at least 24 undergraduate credits or 6 graduate credits by the end of the current academic year, and has a 3.0 GPA or better.
